As we shared in our previous newsletters, our journey has been a constant reassurance of God's presence through many miracles, words of encouragement and renewed strength, as we stood amazed at the hunger and great response to the message of hope throughout the region!

Yet one need remains constant, the need for more workers and churches! When we return for the next term, we will need to address both those needs!

Our vision is to plant at least three more churches in the towns of Ostrov, Coslugea and Canlia! These are village where we have already ministered, gave out bibles and made contacts. There is a great sense of readiness for discipleship and training in these communities!

Our prayer requests are as follow:

1. For churches and individuals to become aware of the need and partner with us to raise 50,000 dollars for each of the three church plants. Pray also that our monthly budget will be raised in time for our return.

3. Pray that God will continue to remove all the obstacles in our path as we advance in enlarging His kingdom.
4. Pray for our team who is working hard at this time to prepare for the evangelism events with the help of Operation Christmas Child gifts for kids. Eight hundred shoe boxes will be given to the children in the region and hundreds more will be given the opportunity to receive the greatest gift of all!
